Helsinki is a huge city and the areas outside of Helsinki Downtown deserve more attention from both locals and tourists



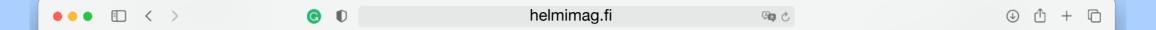

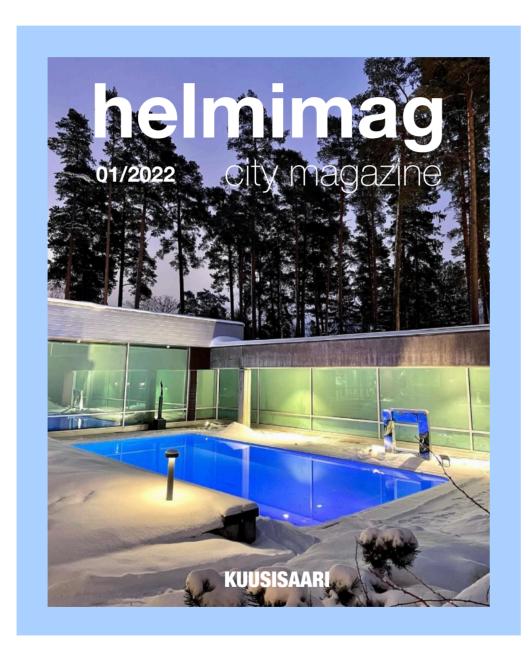

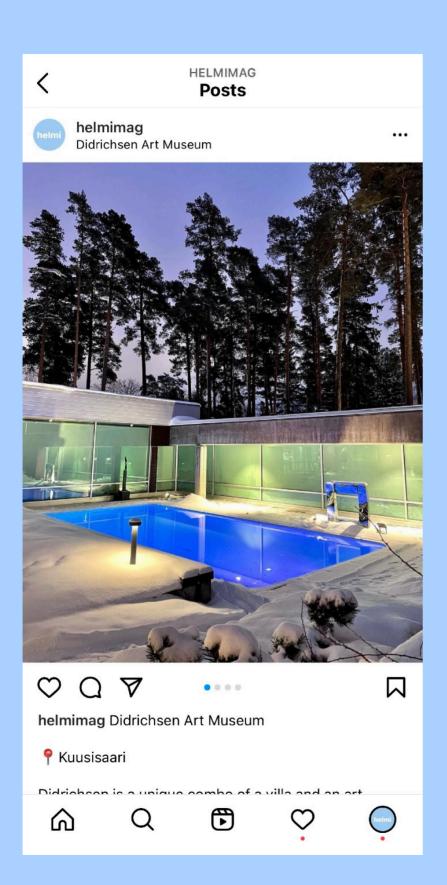
