What happens after the voting?

- The proposals that were voted on and received enough votes to be carried out are developed into feasible solutions with residents and the City's experts.
- The implementation of the proposals will start in autumn 2024.


Here is how you vote in OmaStadi

- 3. Select the area in Helsinki where you want to ast your votes.
- 4. Familiarise yourself with the area's proposals and pick five of them.
- 5. Check your selection and cast your votes. After this, you will no longer be able to change your votes.
