OmaStadi is participatory budgeting by the City of Helsinki.

OmaStadi is participatory budgeting by the City of Helsinki, in which Helsinki allocates 4.4 million euros to realising residents' ideas.

The funds are divided by area in accordance with population size, with one fifth of the funds being reserved for proposals applying to the whole city.

You can choose the area whose plans you want to vote on. Everyone who is eligible to vote* may also vote on plans prepared for the whole city. As a voter, you are allowed to distribute the area-specific appropriation as you please. The plans with the most votes will be realised.

*All residents of Helsinki over the age of 12 or who will turn 12 this year

The voting takes place online and all the plans being put to vote and further information about them can be found at **omastadi.hel.fi**

If you need assistance or if you don't have online bank service certificate/mobile certificate, you may vote by showing an official ID card in specific libraries and community houses.
