Budget for expansive ideas: 1 760 000 euros

Expansive ideas are ideas that are not limited to a single major district. These can include ideas that affect all of Helsinki or ones that target two major districts, for example.

Criteria



Scale

The cost of an individual proposal must be no less than 35,000 euros and no more than half (50%) of the area's budget.

You may submit an idea even if you do not know what its realisation might cost. Ideas are refined together and their costs are evaluated by the City's experts. You can, however, check cost examples in advance at **omastadi.hel.fi**. These examples help you understand what specific services provided by the City or an environmental improvement can cost.



Criteria



Non- recurrent

OmaStadi is about coming up with ideas for projects that are non-recurrent or have a fixed duration.

OmaStadi cannot be used to hire permanent staff, for example.



Criteria



Values and principles

The idea must promote the equality, functionality, safety, sustainability, communality, comfortability or vitality of the city.

The idea must comply with laws and regulations.



Criteria



Realisable by the City

The City must be able to realise the idea. The City cannot realise ideas related to the operations of the police, the Finnish Transport Infrastructure Agency, employment authorities or private companies, for example. Ideas must also concern City-owned plots instead of private areas.

Nor can OmaStadi be used to realise ideas that concern the operations of the City of Helsinki's joint municipal authorities, subsidiary communities or commercial enterprises, such as HSL, HKL, HEKA Oy or Helen Oy.

OmaStadi cannot be used to apply for grants for parties external to the City, such as NGOs or companies.
